#### Southeast 2, Metro 0

Southeast managed only two hits off of Metro pitching, but took advantage of six walks and a few errors to grab a 2-0 victory in the first game of the 2009 Bay State Summer Games.

David Gibson (Hanover; Hanover HS) went the first five innings for Southeast, allowing just three hits while striking out four. Michael DeCosta (Norwood; Norwood HS) came on in the sixth and worked two perfect innings to pick up the save.

Pat Connaughton (Arlington; St. John's Prep) was the hard-luck loser for Metro. The tall right-hander allowed just one hit over his five innings of work and struck out five but surrendered three costly free passes. Southeast took advantage of the walks and grabbed a run in the first inning when Chris Puliafico (Sharon; Sharon HS) drove in Jim Perron (Norwell; Archbishop Williams) with a single to right field. The Southeast (1-0) added an insurance run in the top of the seventh inning off of Metro (0-1) reliever Shane O'Leary (W.
