Northeast 9, Central 1

Lawrence's Junior Vasquez struck out nine and allowed just three runners to reach base in five innings of work as Northeast hammered Central, 9-1, in the 2010 Bay State Summer Games baseball tournament opener.

"My main goal today was throwing strikes, getting ahead in the count, and letting my teammates help me out," Vasquez explained. "I could have been better, but I think I did great today."

Northeast broke open a 3-0 game with six runs in the fifth inning highlighted by an RBI triple from Ben Panunzio (Middleton, Masconomet HS). Matt Tulley (Lowell, Lowell HS) added a double and two RBI in the inning and then took over in relief for Vasquez (Lawrence HS) who saves his last two innings of eligibility on the hill.

"With my last two innings I'm looking to help my team with whatever they need and then be there to cheer them on," Vasquez said. The Bay State Games allows each pitcher to throw seven total innings in the tournament.

David Ruggiero (Peabody, Bishop Fenwick HS) started the offense for Northeast (1-0) with a lead-off double to start the game, and then he came around to score the team's first run.

Central (0-1) scored in the seventh to spoil the shutout. Steve Wallace (Auburn, Auburn HS) singled and moved to third after a passed ball and wild pitch. Anthony Gingerelli (Worcester, Burncoat HS) then smacked a base hit to knock in Wallace.
